Measures taken last year to ensure the hall was Covid-secure will remain in place, including anti-bacterial hand gels and a new Perspex screen across the servery hatch. Partygoers will also be asked to observe any government advice on social distancing.

Charminster Fête is returning this summer – bigger and better than ever!

After last year's cancellation, the fête committee has announced that this year's event will be held in the gardens of Charminster House on Saturday, August 21st.

The fête will be opened by BBC antiques expert Timothy Medhurst and it promises to be an afternoon of fun and entertainment.

Old favourites

"After the terrible year we've just been through, we thought villagers would welcome the chance to get together and enjoy themselves," said fête chairman Nigel Kay. "We've only just begun planning, but we know already that many old favourites will be returning."

Highlights include the family dog show and a charity duck race along

the river. Among the classes will be prizes for the dog which looks most like its owner, and for the best junior handler. "Although keeping the dogs off the ducks, may be a challenge," said Nigel.

Also returning are Punch and Judy, as well as the bric-a-brac and book stalls. There will be a licensed bar and live music.

One new feature will be a valuation stall run by coin specialist Timothy Medhurst. Regular viewers of Antiques Road Trip will be aware that Tim has a wide knowledge of antiques and collectibles, not just coins. He has just finished filming a new series of the BBC show in Wales. So dig out your treasured family heirlooms and bring them along to the fête where Tim will value them in return for a small donation to the fête's charity appeal.

From the Clergy...

On a cruise, says Maisie in a Schultz Peanuts cartoon, some people face their deckchairs to see where they are going, while others prefer to look back on where they've been. Meantime, Charlie Brown doesn't know which way he would face as he's never been able to unfold a deck-chair!

The humour of Charles Schulz in his 'Peanuts' cartoon puts its finger on the confusion that many of us feel when facing the many issues of life today. The past year has been so tough for so many – do we look back or are we looking forward? Despair or hope?

No bitterness

I was very moved by a young woman, Grace, who was interviewed on Radio 4. She was so bright and positive. She had just qualified as a doctor and was looking forward to practising – an ambition she had since a young girl. But she's now in a wheelchair after a man threw himself off a balcony in a shopping mall and landed on top of

her breaking her spine. There was no hint of bitterness and when asked if she was angry with the man, she said that she had never felt any anger and felt that any negative emotion would damage her interior life. She accepted her condition and said she would use all the skills she has to benefit others and she was very happy.

We've just celebrated Easter. On Good Friday, Jesus' disciples were deeply distressed at what had happened and on the Sunday evening, some of them were met together but did not believe the women who told them Jesus was alive.

Holy Spirit

Then Jesus comes among them and says, 'Peace be with you'. He calms them and then tells them to go out and continue the ministry that he had begun. He breathed on them and said 'Receive the Holy Spirit'. His words were fulfilled on the day of Pentecost when the disciples were filled with the Holy Spirit and went out to proclaim the good news. They became a

community of love and unity that had an enormous impact. They moved from fear to faith, from looking back in despair to looking forward in hope.

In one way, it's not wrong to look back. We can look back and thank God for people who have inspired us and events from which we can learn and grow.

None of us knows what the future holds but we can be sure that God holds the future and He will hold us in his hands. Jesus said that no-one can take us out of his or his Father's

hands. This is the Christians' hope that came at Pentecost, which we celebrate this month. It is hope based on the promises of God. He doesn't promise that there will be no hills or hardships, but He has promised never to leave us or forsake us. "Even when you go through the valley of the shadow of death, I will be with you" (Psalm 23).

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope' (St. Paul)



Village News in Brief

Charminster Parish Council have given the green light to proposals for a major extension to Wolfeton Manor Care Home. The extension will create spacious new rooms for residents and lead to more job opportunities at the home. Councillors agreed to the demolition of an old building in the grounds and a new south-east facing extension built of zinc and glass.

CLlr Peter Dangerfield said the plans reminded him of a south London comprehensive school, but he was full of praise for the light airy rooms which would significantly improve facilities for residents.

The plans must still be approved by Dorset Council.

The parish council is to spend £200 planting a wildflower border alongside the new footpath currently being built at Higher Charminster.

Councillors agreed a £750 grant to The Pilot. Tim Yarker told the council that the magazine circulation was being increased to match the expanding size of the village. Members expressed their appreciation for the magazine, describing it as a valuable resource.

A proposal to create a secure dog training area in the Charlton Down community orchard was rejected by parish councillors. Members were concerned about the potential problem of dog fouling in an area much used by families.

The easing of the government's lockdown restrictions means Herrison Hall and Charminster's Community Hall will be reopening from May 17th.
