

Hearing dogs charm WI

Hearing Dogs for the Deaf joined Charminster WI at their latest meeting, writes Judy Bird.

We had two couples with two dogs, who each talked to us about how the Hearing Dogs scheme works. Deb (who is profoundly deaf, but is helped by hearing aids) was accompanied by her husband Keith, and her Hearing Dog, Elmo. Debbie and John Patterson brought along their Ambassador Dog, Flash. Both the dogs are black labradors, but other breeds can be trained to assist deaf people.

Six sounds

They are trained to voice and hand signals, and are carefully matched to a deaf person so that the dog's skills and personality perfectly suit the lifestyle and needs of their partner. Elmo is trained for six sounds – fire alarm, door bell, phone, alarm clock, kitchen timer and 'call' (for instance, if Deb's husband had a fall and called out, Deb couldn't hear, so Elmo would alert her).

Debbie introduced us to Flash their

Ambassador Dog. He wasn't trained as a Hearing Dog but makes an excellent ambassador for the charity. Debbie and her husband are also volunteer dog trainers. A dog's training takes around 18 to 24 months, during which time they learn how to be a well-behaved dog and how to alert a deaf person to important sounds.

With almost one in six of the UK population experiencing some level of deafness or hearing loss, demand for the services of Hearing Dogs is evergrowing. The charity relies solely on the support of the public. We were glad to be able to give a generous donation.



Next month we will be meeting on 12th July, at 7.30 pm, again at the Community Hall. We will be decorating small square of fabric to be donated to the County Museum to make a quilt. You would be welcome to join us.





Ribbons, flowers and even The Pilot, got in on the act!



Q. Is there anything that can be done about the ongoing traffic issues facing Charminster?

A: Whilst the recent closure of the Sherborne road for bridge repairs has exasperated the problem, Charminster in particular has had some long standing traffic issues. There are also further problems that affect other areas as well, such as parking on the pavement, lack of footways in some areas and speeding. Many of these problems are not easy to solve but there is no co-ordinated highways strategy for the village. Everything seems to be dealt with in an ad hoc way, by the Highways Authority (Dorset Council.) However, we must be aware, we are all part of the problem, we have more cars than ever and constantly buy things online, requiring delivery. Busier roads reflect our busy lifestyles.

Quite a lot has been done already including, for example the widespread 20mph speed limits.

But the first thing to do is gather the data we have on traffic and then involve you as residents to tell us what matters to you.
