#### Platinum Champion

As a small child Richard Courtney Cripwell wanted everyone to be happy. By the time he was eight, he'd modified his bike to enable him to run errands and do odd jobs for people while cheering them up.

And that desire to help and reduce conflict and unhappiness in people's lives has never left him – and has now resulted in him being given a <u>Platinum Champion</u> award for outstanding service and dedication to Crisis and Welfare over the last 20 years.

Now working as an independent diplomatic negotiator, the father of three from Stinsford uses his instincts and experience to diffuse conflict and tension in a variety of circumstances, and is regularly called upon to help by the NHS, the prison service, the police and other organisations.

"I am completely independent – I do not and cannot take sides. I try to create a calm atmosphere where there is conflict, violence, potential suicide or problems perhaps with bullying on a corporate or personal level that's causing a lot of stress," said Richard.

The former actor and production company boss has always kept quiet about his negotiating activities, but the Platinum Champion award — which was presented to him at Buckingham Palace by the Duchess of Cornwall and was followed by lunch at Windsor Castle — has made him realise that people need to know that he and people like him exist.

"I want to raise awareness, particularly here in rural Dorset, that help is at hand and we can find a way out. out .for people in despair or in extremely stressful situations."

He kindly ordered the metal letters; the old Council having taken away the original post and returned the one we were replacing with plastic stick on letters, no good to man nor beast. Thanks also go to Kevin Dean and his students from the Kingston Maurward welding department for all the pre preparation done with the letters from the foundry, cleaning, drilling out the screw holes and painting them. These in turn, all 122, were passed to Chris Groves, whom many of you will know, to make up the boards; Chris both worked for the Dorset Echo and as a professional signwriter. We put the HIGHER and LOWER Bockhamptons in two strings thus allowing shorter boards in the hope there was less chance of them being damaged by larger vehicles often sent down Cuckoo Lane when there has been a road traffic accident on the A35. Then it was back to Kevin and his team, examinations having been completed, to erect the post. A job very well done.

# CHARMINSTER PLATINUM JUBILEE FÊTE JUNE 2022 ALLOCATION OF GIFTS

At their final meeting the Platinum Jubilee fête team allocated one-off gifts from the Platinum Jubilee fête proceeds of £8,700. Allocation of these Jubilee Gifts focused on those organizations which benefit the community in various ways, with a particular emphasis on the young and elderly. - £250 to *The Pilot* for promotion of village events
- £200 to Charlton Down Village Hall for loan of equipment
- £200 to Charminster Community Hall for loan of equipment
- £50 to Charminster WI for their new fête teapot & aprons!!
- £1,000 remains as Charminster Fête's Reserve for 2023 to enable it to get started.

#### **Beetroot Brownies**

Believe it or not, beetroot is a delicious addition to these chocolate brownies, adding a depth of flavour and a squidgy texture. If you have the willpower, leave these overnight before cutting into squares. The fudgy texture will be worth the wait!

It takes 1 hour 45 minutes and makes 20 squares

# **Ingredients**

375g raw beetroot

250g dark chocolate, chopped

250g unsalted butter, cut into cubes

3 medium eggs

250g caster sugar

150g wholemeal self-raising flour

½ tbsp cocoa powder

#### Method

**Preheat** your oven to 180°C/160°C fan/gas mark 4.

Grease and line a 20cm square cake tin. Prepare your beetroot by trimming off any leaves, then peel and cut into quarters. Add to a microwaveable bowl with a splash of water and cover with cling-film. Cook on high power for 10-12 minutes until cooked through. Leave until cool enough to handle and then grate – you should be left with approximately 250g cooked beetroot. Set aside.

**Place** a medium saucepan of water on the stove and fill a third of the way with water. Bring to a simmer and place a large heatproof bowl on top, adding the chocolate and butter. Stir the chocolate and butter until melted, then remove.

Whisk the eggs and sugar together until thick and creamy. Pour in the melted chocolate, then fold until combined. Add the flour and cocoa and fold until combined, then fold through the grated beetroot.

**Pour** the brownie mix into the lined tin. Spread out so the surface is even, then bake for 55 minutes to 1 hour until only a few crumbs remain when you poke with a skewer or cocktail stick.

**Remove** the brownies from the oven and place on a wire rack. Leave until entirely cool, then lift out of the tin. Dust with the cocoa powder and cut into 20 squares.






