Charminster Parish Council meeting Tuesday 7th February 2023 at Charminster Community Hall at 7pm

Minutes

MS welcomed everyone to the meeting at 7.02pm

- 2023/001 **Declarations of Interest** to record declarations of interest in any item on the agenda. None
- 2023/002 **To consider grant of dispensations**None received.
- 2023/003 **To receive apologies for absence**Apologies had been received from Geri Brown
- 2023/004 **To approve the minutes** of the meeting held on 6th December 2022 KB proposed the minutes be approved. RW seconded. Majority in favour. MS signed and dated the minutes.
- 2023/005 Matters arising from the above minutes

 The Clerk confirmed the raised pavement had been repaired by Dorset Council.
- 2023/006 Public Discussion Period

MS suspended the formal part of the meeting at 7.04pm

Cllr Taylor spoke about an issue affecting a resident of West Hill where trees in the neighbouring garden have been assessed as being diseased and/or dying and posing a potential threat to neighbouring properties. Cllr Taylor requested the Parish Council write to the owners of the trees to request they carry out remedial works. MS resumed the formal part of the meeting to enable members to discuss the request. CM proposed the clerk write to the tree owners. RE seconded. Majority in favour.

MS suspended the formal part of the meeting again at 7.12pm

A resident highlighted the ongoing problem of litter in Wanchard Lane and Drakes Lane. The litter includes empty alcohol bottles. PCSO Sarah Pilcher is aware.

The issue of flooding at the bottom of Church Lane was discussed. MS explained that the Environment Agency had requested the Diocese allow a larger soakaway to be built prior to the new path being installed but the Diocese had refused permission. It was agreed the Clerk will contact the Diocese again and ask them to reconsider their decision and allow a suitable sized soakaway.

The Charminster Fete will be held on Saturday 3rd June and the Pre-School/School funday will be held on 9th July.

A resident of Charminster Farm spoke about the yellow grit bins that have been installed in Charminster Farm by the management company (Blenheim). It was agreed the Clerk will contact Wyatt Homes and Blenheim to ask them if the bins are permanent and if their positioning and colour have been agreed with Dorset Council.

The problems of sewage along North Street was discussed at length. It was agreed the Clerk will contact Wessex Water again and ask for clarification on the issues and how they will be resolved.

Erect single storey rear extension

RW confirmed he had spoken to neighbours and none had any objections. RW proposed the Parish Council raise no objection to the application. CM seconded. Majority in favour.

Erect barn for indoor swimming pool and conversion of workshop for to home office, home gym and changing room.

2023/008 Finance

- a) Financial Statement
 MS checked the bank statements against the financial statement.
- b) Payments to be agreed MS requested he be reimbursed for the expenditure he incurred fixing the CD swing, Princes Plot information panel and benches totalling £92.20. KB proposed accepting the financial statement and all payments including the additional payment. CM seconded. Majority in favour.

2023/009 Charlton Down Nature Area and Orchard

- a) Discuss quotes for repair and refurbishment of pond This item was discussed at length. Concerns were raised about the type of liner being proposed. It was agreed that CM and RW would obtain additional quotes with some including a concrete or clay lining.
- b) Nature Reserve Sign A Charlton Down resident has kindly offered to repair the sign. RE proposed spending up to £50 on the repairs. RW seconded. Majority in favour.
- Repair or replacement of picnic table
 RW proposed the vandalised table be removed and offered to remove it. RE seconded. Majority in favour.

2023/010 Millers Orchard

- a) Request for bench in Millers Orchard

PD and LP agreed to write a proposal for Millers Orchard that would include the pruning of the trees, seating and signage.

2023/011 Princes Plot – Maintenance Contract

TY proposed accepting the proposed quote for the annual work for Princes Plot totalling £1300. The contractor will invoice after each cut.

PD seconded. Majority in favour.

2023/012 Grit Bins

TY proposed purchasing a large grit bin for Sodern Lane (£260 + VAT) and repositioning it to the other side of the road to make access easier. The Clerk will speak to Highways about installing a smaller grit bin (£222 + VAT) at the junction of the C12 and East Hill. There will be additional costs for the concrete bases required.

2023/013 Coronation Events

OG proposed spending £60 on prizes for the Decorate your House competition and up to £150 on a plaque to go in front of the flagpole that will commemorate the Coronation. RW seconded. Majority in favour.

2023/014 30mph Speedwatch Team

CM informed the meeting that the 30mph team have been carrying out speedwatch for 10 years and will be stepping down in July, in part due to a lack of new volunteers. TY proposed a vote of thanks to the team for all they have done. A request for new volunteers will be put in the Pilot.
