

Stinsford News

The first week in May, and it is cold with, on occasions, an Easterly wind. It is good to see the sun although its appearance is a rarity. On the brighter side no frosts as per last year and the fruit blossom this year has been exceptional on the Concorde and Doyenne du Comice pears and as to Damson, even more so. Looking forward to seeing what comes of the cherries and apples. The Daffodils and tulips around the parish have performed wonderfully with delightful and magnificent displays of very attractive new varieties.

I am trying "the no dig" system this year in part of the garden. A technique that quite literally involves the minimal amount of digging, many individuals view it as a less strenuous but effective way of gardening. Unlike traditional gardening methods, no dig uses organic matter to naturally eliminate weeds and some choose this gardening method to grow organic vegetables. I am finding it thoughtful and challenging - will be interesting to see the outcome.

The last Sunday in April at Stinsford, what a fifth Sunday of the month service that was! Our Organist was in fine form, with much practice happening in preparation for our Coronation "Songs of Praise" Service to come the following weekend his finale was *Zadok the Priest* as his closing anthem. The hymns and singing were great and glorious and Rob's sermon as thought provoking as ever. This was the first occasion that the fifth Sunday's collection would go to an agreed charity and the Sudan had been chosen. As we presently find the Sudan in great conflict the sum of £158 collected will go to the Sudan Crisis Relief Fund. Thank you to all who gave so generously.

And so to the Coronation and crowning of King Charles 111 and Queen Camilla. At our Sunday celebrations twelve hymns had been chosen for their rousing tunes ending with all three verses of the National Anthem and three cheers. Shirley then ended the service with a simple closing prayer, and we all ended with the Grace. This was followed by a slice of a spectacular, perfectly made 'Union Jack' cake and a glass of fizz raised to our newly crowned King. Then to our 'street party,' tables and chairs, music, wine and food and some glorious sunshine, all within the church car park.

As you read this, thoughts will be turning to June and the Hardy Birthday Celebration Service. Channel 5 have approached the Hardy Society who in turn have approached the PCC with regard to filming the service. They are producing a series of recordings around the country and the belief is “you cannot do Dorset without a reference to Hardy” and Mellstock is its centre. We in turn, knowing the Archdeacon is to preach, asked Leila to approach her as to her thoughts on the matter. Archdeacon Penny has been most supportive and made us aware of the manner in which it could be carried out.

There are certain rules that need to be applied:

The congregation need to know in advance that the service is being filmed in case they do not wish to be on camera. There needs to be a designated area where those in the congregation who wish to attend but do not want to be ‘on camera’ can sit and to check any copyright issues. So we are now planning to put Stinsford yet again back on the national map and are looking forward to the event.

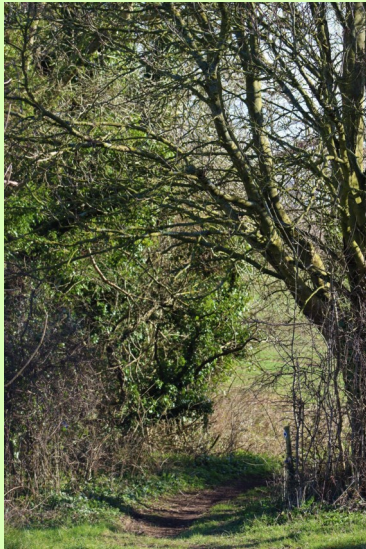


News from Stinsford Parish Council

Sunday 18th June – Come for a walk.

There is a long history of parish bounds walks in England. Sometimes they are known as beating the bounds. The tradition dates back at least to the middle ages. In most cases it amounted to a walk or ride around the perimeter of the parish. Very often parishes had boundary stones. Some traditions saw hymns sung when the walk arrived at each stone or stones were thrashed with sticks as in 'beating the bounds' or blessed. There was some variation in dates for the walk in different localities although most took place on Ascension day or five weeks after Easter Sunday. In some places the event lost all religious ties. In some northern towns like Berwick on Tweed it has always been carried out by horse riders and now involves hundreds of riders entering through the town gates to be met by huge crowds in the market place.

Stinsford has previously held bounds walks but in recent times they have been irregular. To walk the exact boundaries of Stinsford is difficult because of the health and safety implications of crossing the A35 and contemporary land ownership patterns. There are no known existing boundary stones. Nevertheless we would like to reinstate an annual walk as close to the parish boundaries as possible using public rights of way.



We intend to do the walk on Sunday 18th June. We will start at 10am at the lower car park at Kingston Maurward College. The walk will head to the river footpath and follow it into Lower Bockhampton and on to Bhompston. From there we will follow the path northward past the Pine Lodge Tea Room and through the forest to Higher Bockhampton. From Hardy's Cottage we will walk up the delightfully named Snails Creep, over the A35 bridge and follow the now little used old A35 to Yellowham Wood. At this point we leave the Parish to climb up onto Waterston Ridge and follow it west crossing Slyers Lane / Piddlehinton Road with spectacular views across the higher parts of the parish before descending to Fiddlers Green with its huge ancient barrow and the ruins of the cottage associated with Hardy's story The Three Strangers. The path takes us on through Triangle Copse and briefly into Charminster Parish at Segars Barn before climbing up again to follow the delightful old drovers track known as Lovers Lane back down to Frome Whitfield from where we follow the path to Blue Bridge and back through the water meadows to Greys Bridge and a very short stretch of the London Road footpath before rejoining the riverside path back to Stinsford, St Michael's Church and Kingston Maurward.

It's quite a long route – Stinsford is a relatively large rural parish and the bounds walk is over 12 miles. It is an unquestionably scenic route offering a wide variety of countryside from the water meadows through beautiful woodland and the high expansive scenery from the chalk downland in the North of the parish. We will try and arrange a number of stops. It does require appropriate footwear, none of it is particularly difficult going but in places it can be muddy in wet weather so boots are advisable. If wish to join the Stinsford Parish Council Face Book site we could discuss some of the finer details nearer the time. We hope to see as many of you as possible but even if you are not walking please feel free to turn up to wave us off, and with your support, we can make this an annual event again.
